

Process Overview:

QUICK CHECKS	
Check your documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Confirm that your passport is valid for at least another 6 months and has 2 blank pages marked VISA front and back at the time of application. Ensure that your driver's license will still be valid for at least six months after you arrive in the Netherlands.
Share dependent information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inform us about the partner and/or dependents you will be immigrating with.
Inform us if...	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you plan on visiting another country, for which you require a VISA, during the course of the immigration process please inform us as this could require additional planning. If your job title, start date, location, or salary changes at any point in the process.

FIRST STEPS	
Applications for MVV entry VISA and Residence Permits For: knowledge migrant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collect the documents requested in the adjoining email and send them to your relocation consultant. Sign and send the antecedent statements. Once the documentation is complete we can submit the application. If accepted, we will receive your Pre-Approval Letter from the IND. Once the Pre-Approval letter is received for your application we can schedule you an appointment at the Dutch embassy in your current country of residence – if applicable.
Applications for MVV entry VISA and Residence Permits For: Partner and/or children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collect the documents requested in the adjoining email and send them to your relocation consultant. Sign and send the antecedent statements. Before we can submit an application for a spouse or child we will require your legalised documents to share with the IND. Legalization advice information can be found in the next step. Once the documentation is complete we can submit the application. If accepted, we will receive your Pre-Approval Letter from the IND.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Once the Pre-Approval letter is received for your application we can schedule you an appointment at the Dutch embassy in your current country of residence – if applicable.
Legalization Advice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> After sharing your passport copies you will receive legalization advice based on your passport. After receiving the advice you should start the legalization process directly to avoid delays in the process. <p><small>*Correctly legalized documents (these can vary but most often include marriage and birth certificates) will be required for your immigration and registration process.</small></p>
Home Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will receive information about your home search process in a separate email shortly.
School Search For: children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will receive information about how we will search for a suitable school for your children if applicable.

IN THE WEEKS DIRECTLY AFTER YOUR ARRIVAL IN THE NETHERLANDS

Registration IND	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will schedule an appointment for you to collect your residence permit from an IND desk.
Registering at City Hall and receiving your BSN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will schedule an appointment for you to visit your local city hall to complete your registration in the Netherlands. At your appointment you will obtain a BSN (Burgerservicenummer), also known as a social security number.
Opening a bank account	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will schedule an appointment and go with you to open a Dutch bank account at ABN AMRO bank.

WITHIN THE FIRST 6 MONTHS AFTER YOU ARRIVE IN THE NETHERLANDS

*Tuberculosis Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you are traveling from a higher TB risk country you may be required to take a tuberculosis test. An appointment will be scheduled for you if needed.
Application 30% tax ruling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you are eligible we can start the process of requesting this benefit for you. We work with a partner who will fast-track the process. The application typically takes a few months, but it will apply to the salary you earn from the start date on your employment contract.
Health Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your relocation consultant will share information about Zilveren Kruis health insurance and apply for health insurance for you. Health insurance is mandatory in the Netherlands. We will share information about a local General Practitioner (GP) and dentist where you can register yourself as a patient.

<p>General welfare for children For: children</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will assist you with your application for child benefits. Parents of children under 18 are eligible for the benefit and can receive money from the government to put towards the costs of raising a child.
<p>Driving license exchange</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Once your 30% ruling is approved an appointment will be made for you to exchange your driver's license for a Dutch one. <p><small>*Your spouse will also be eligible to exchange their driver's license and can make their own appointment after yours.</small></p>
